



Goa CM Announces 6,000–8,000 Government Jobs In Six Months

■ Sawant highlights transparent recruitment, Porvorim elevated corridor, Happiness Index and environmental conservation

PANAJI: Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant on Independence Day announced that the Goa government will create opportunities for 6,000 to 8,000 government jobs over the next six months, making employment a major focus of his address. He said fresh recruitment drives would be undertaken to fill vacancies and provide more opportunities to the state's youth. Sawant also stressed that government recruitment would remain transparent and merit-based. Referring to the Goa Staff Selection Commission (GSSC), he said the commission follows a transparent recruitment process and rejected the perception that government jobs can be secured through personal influence or



connections. On infrastructure, Sawant announced that the Porvorim elevated corridor is expected to be opened to the public before Ganesh Chaturthi. He said improvements in roads, national highways, bridges and elevated corridors have contributed to better connectivity and eased commuting in the state. The Chief Minister also

highlighted Goa's adoption of the Happiness Index, saying the initiative reflects a broader approach to development that takes citizens' well-being and quality of life into account. He said Goa's progress must be measured not only through infrastructure and economic growth but also through the happiness and welfare of its people.
